MY SCHOOL LIFE





SETTING UP NEW CLUBS - D & T CLUB




Also, students in our school like designing and making models very much. We can make something useful for home use or personal use in our daily lives

(Logo of D & T Club)




SETTING UP NEW CLUBS - PHOTOGRAPHY CLUB

In this club, we will teach students how to take beautiful photos and different techniques in capturing photos. We can also share our snapshots with other classmates in the club.


Besides, we can be the photographers of the special events of SFCC's 10th Anniversary. We will specialize in capturing the most precious moments during the celebrations.


