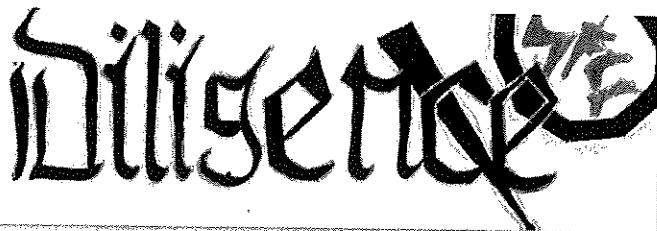

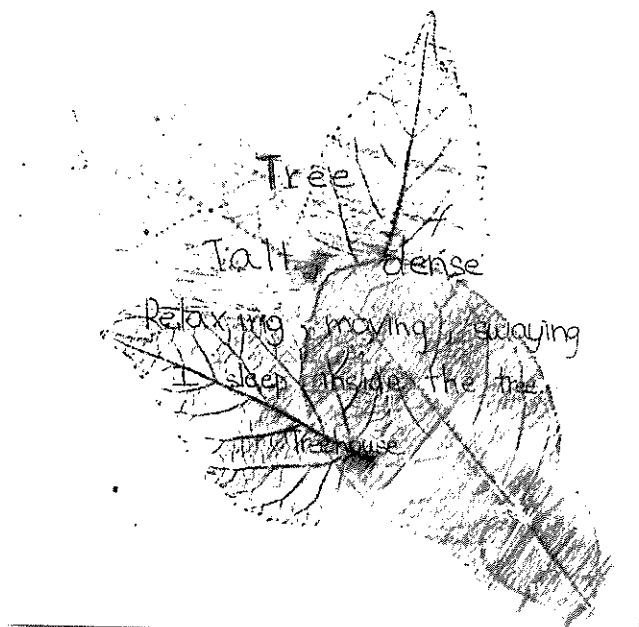

FILM REVIEW - KARATE KID

This film is about Dre Parker (Jaden Smith), a 12-year-old boy who moves from Detroit to China with his mother (Taraji P. Henson) where she finds a new job. Dre struggles to fit in to his new school where he comes across his classmate Mei Ying (Wenwen Han), the bully in the class, who makes it his mission to torture Dre together with his friends. One such encounter results in Dre being beaten up particularly badly until the maintenance man of Dre's apartment building, Mr. Han (Jackie Chan), arrives and ends the fight. Being a secret master of kung fu, Mr. Han mentors Dre in martial arts in an attempt to rebuild his confidence and confront the bullies who humiliated him in a massive kung fu tournament.

There are some prestigious names in this film. For example, the director is Harald Zwart, the screenplay writer is Christopher Murphy, the script writer is Robert Mark Kamen and the leading characters include Jaden Smith, Jackie Chan and Taraji P. Henson.

The overall plot of the film is about a kid who has a clear goal in mind. It wants to tell a story of coming-of-age in a way that excites a young audience with an adventurous feeling. With this in mind, the film is a huge success. The fight scenes are thrilling and the film just looks gorgeous as Mr. Han and Dre's training takes them from the Great Wall to the Forbidden City. The story gives the audience a sense of wonder and grandeur, thus making it somewhat epic.

However, there are also failures in the film. For instance, it rambles too much on boring details but misses several opportunities to reveal something about the Parker family other than their moving to China and the beating up of their son. But still, if we don't consider the movie as in-depth and thought-provoking, but rather as entertainment, it does very well in catching the eyes of young people with dynamic kung fu.

FILM REVIEW - POLICE STORY 5

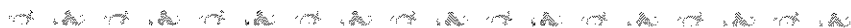
Police Story 5 is a very famous action film directed by Jackie Chan. There were four previous films with the first one shown in 1985 and the last shown in 1996.

REPORT ON HOBBIES AMONG TEENAGERS

Introduction

Third, some children do not go back home every day because they live far away from school, so they live in school instead. But there are no standard dormitories at their schools. Why don't we help them build a dormitory? We could donate money to them so that they would have a nice dormitory to stay in and they would not need to walk to and from school every day.

To conclude, there are many problems with education and the learning environment in rural China, so we must give them a hand to make a change.
