





1. Horrified workers at a government office block in Wan Chai yesterday found the body of a woman in a machine room where they had worked for several hours without realising it was there.




2. The body, hands bound with a black nylon rope, was found lying face up on a ventilation machine in the room on the 33rd floor of Revenue Tower at about 12.30 p.m.



3. One of the workers found the body when he tried to put some tools on top of the machine as he broke for lunch.



4. The body of the Chinese woman was dressed in a white T-shirt and black trousers. A pair of high-heeled sandals was found nearby. The deceased had long hair with red highlights.

# Police suspect foul play after corpse found




Topic : Crime (Murder)

1. Police are investigating the death of a 22-year old man whose body was found in a park at Chai Wan early yesterday morning with head and neck injuries.




2. The park was built on a service reservoir at the junction of Tai Tam Road and Chai Wan Road near the Eastern Hospital.

The body was discovered by an elderly man when he walked through the park- built on a service reservoir at the junction of Tai Tam Road and Chai Wan Road near the Eastern Hospital- shortly before 6:30 a.m. for a morning exercise.




3. Emergency Services rushed to the scene immediately after receiving an alarm call from the 76-year-old man. "He reported that he found a man who was inactive and motionless," a police spokesman said.




4. Rescuers declared the man dead when they arrived at the scene.

The victim was wearing a black top, jeans and white sports shoes and was found lying in the middle of the park, on a small piece of grass-land.

An identity card was found on the body that indicated the man was 22 and his surname was Wong.




5. Forensic scientists were called to examine the scene, covering the body with a tent before removing it at 3 p.m. and taking it to the public mortuary in the Western.



6. A police source said the case was suspicious because the man had bruises on his head and neck.


“We still do not know the cause of death. We can confirm that we did not find any blood but we did find obvious bruises on the right of his head and on the left of his neck,” the source said.

He added that initial investigations indicated that the man was attacked with a hard object before his death.




7. A post mortem examination will be carried out today.


The park where the body was found was built on a service reservoir that treats and supplies water to residents in Chai Wan.



8. Residents said that although there were no recreational facilities or lights in the park, many elderly people liked to go there for morning exercises and some people played cricket there.

Few people went to the park at night due to lack of lighting.


