



The Boy and The Dog



Suddenly, Bobby was sick and then he died.




Bobby was dead and Tommy felt very sad.




The Boy and Princess


Once upon a time, there was a boy and a princess who grew up together. They loved each other and were very happy.


The princess wanted to marry the boy, but the princess' mother said they could not do it.


After that, they didn't speak to each other because the princess was getting married to the prince. One day, the boy and the princess wanted to see each other so they met.
